Subject: **Notice of Suspension for Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) No. 4IP-01-056 for the product Vacciplant and Certificate of Registration (COR) No. IP-OBCA-049 for UPL Philippines, Inc.**

Dear **Ms. Sierra**:

This letter serves as a formal Notice of Suspension of your company's Certificate of Registration (COR) and product's Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) effective August 04, 2022.

As basis for the suspension, we quote Article XIV of the Department Circular (DC) No. 05, Series of 2020 which states that ***"the COR and CPR shall be suspended based on the non-submission of a new organic certificate within one (1) month after its expiration"***.

Your Organic Certificate No. 056121-1, issued by OCCP-ICSI expired on June 15, 2022. To date, the BAFS has not received any reply despite our email reminders sent on May 11 and August 1, 2022, requesting the submission of an updated OC.

However, should you decide to renew, you may apply for an appeal for reconsideration following the procedures stated in Clause 1.2, Section 1, Article XVI of DC 05 series of 2020. An OC submitted within two months will lift the suspension of COR and CPR. Should we not receive the updated OC, your COR and CPR will be eventually revoked.
