AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND ATTEND ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE - BUREAU OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES STANDARDS (DA-BAFS) TECHNICAL SERVICES DIVISION (TSD) RELATED TO THE RAPID EVALUATION OF THE USE AND IMPACT OF PHILIPPINE NATIONAL STANDARDS (PNS) FROM JULY TO

**DECEMBER 2024** 

In the interest of the service, the DA-BAFS TSD shall conduct activities related to the rapid evaluation of the use and Impact of PNS by DA regulatory agencies. These activities include validity and reliability testings of the survey questionnaire, actual data gathering, focus group discussions, and consultations/workshops.

Pursuant to these activities, this Order authorizes the DA-BAFS Director, DA-BAFS TSD and Information Technology Unit (ITU) personnel, Evaluation Reference Group (ERG) per DA Special Order No. 847, Series of 2024, and Technical Working Group (TWG) involved in the development of PNS to participate in the following activities:
