Organic Soil Amendments OSA & Organic Bio-Control Agents (OBCA)

Important Reminders:

- 1. This checklist applies only to those products with organic claims.
- 2. The Organic Certificate (OC) is a prerequisite for the registration of OSA or OBCA products.
- 3. The valid OC qualifies organic input (OSA or OBCA) producers for automatic enrolment in the DA-BAFS Registry and issuance of Certificate of Registration (COR).

APPLYING FOR EXPERIMENTAL USE PERMIT (EUP) FOR **OBCA PRODUCT (LOCAL OR IMPORTED)**

For product registration of OBCA, the two efficacy data for a particular crop-pest(s) combination are prerequisite. The EUP shall be secured before the conduct of efficacy trials. The following requirements, with authorized name and signature, shall be submitted to DA-BAFS, through its OAD-RS:

A. EUP for Product Registration

<u>2</u> .	Efficacy Trial Protocol (ETP) prepared by a DA-BAFS officially – accredited OBCA researcher. The OBCA researcher is required to accomplish the ETP matrix provided by DA-BAFS.

B. EUP for Other Purposes (Product Research and Development, Emergency-use, and Off-label)
